Signing of a major helicopter agreement

Airlift and Dancopter have entered an agreement with the oil companies Det Norske and Revus. The agreement entails a turnover of approx. 40 million DKK annually.

Airlift AS and DanCopter A/S have entered a 3-year agreement with the Norwegian oil companies "Det norske oljeselskap ASA" and "Revus Energy ASA" for offshore helicopter transportation. The agreement will commence 1 March 2009, with an option for 3 x 1 year.

The agreement concerns transportation of passengers and material in connection with the companies' drilling activities on Norwegian base. The helicopter type chosen is EC155. The operation will be based in Bergen - hereafter the base will move to where the drilling activities take place.

EC155 is a modern, midsized helicopter with a capacity of accomodating up to 12 passengers. The helicopter is very suitable for transportation within the oil industry offshore.

Airlift and DanCopter both belong under the Norwegian group Blueway AS and have all together a fleet of 25 helicopters. The companies have further options for delivery of additional helicopters to the oil industry.
